



Late Deaconess (Professor) Enobong D. Umoh was born in 1957 into the family of Elder Bassey Imeh Ekanem of Nung Akpn Uko in Mbiotto II, Etinan L.G.A. Her mother was late Deaconess Nkoyo Bssey Imeh also of Nung Akpan Uko in Mbiotto II in Etinan L.G.A. of Akwa Ibom State.

#### **EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND**

Late Deaconess (Professor) Enobong D. Umoh started her primary Education at T.T.C. Practicing School, Ikot Obio Itong, Opobo (now Ikot Abasi) local Government Area from 1963 to 1969 where she obtained her standard six certificate. For her secondary education, she attended Que Iboe Church Mission Secondary School, Etinan (now Etinan Institute, Etinan, Akwa Ibome State). She obtained her General Certificate of Education (GCE) in 1972. She was admitted into The Polytechnic Calabar to study secretarial administration in 1973. In 1975, the Institution found her worthy in character and in learning hence awarded her an Ordinary National Diploma (OND).

Mummy proceeded back to school in for her Higher National Diploma (HND) 1980 and was awarded same in 1981. In her quest to become a lecturer, Late Deaconess (Professor) Enobong D. Umoh obtained higher degrees as follows: Post graduate Diploma in Public Administration from the University of Calabar in 1987, a Master's Degree in Public Administration from the University of Uyo in 1994, and finally, a Doctorate Degree in Philosophy (Ph.D) degree in political science from the university of Calabar in 2001.

#### CAREER

Late Deaconess (Professor) Enobong D. Umoh started her career as officer in charge of information and records unit at the Polytechnic Calabar, from 1984 – 1986. She became the school officer, School of Education at the same institution from 1986 – 1987. She was then appointed officer in charge of Establishment, The Polytechnic Calabar, Obio Akpa Campus from 1987 -1989. She joined The University of Uyo as a non-teaching staff in 1990. At the University of Uyo, she was the Secretary, Post Graduate School from 1990 – 1992, Secretary, Board of the Post Graduate School (1990-1992), Secretary, University research committee in 1992. In 1992 she was appointed officer in charge of Junior Establishment at the University of Uyo. She held the position till 1993.

Late Deaconess (Professor) Enobong D. Umoh was appointed as an Assistant Lecturer by the governing council of the University of Uyo in 1996. She rose through the ranks from assistant lecturer in 1996 to lecturer II in 2001. She was promoted to the rank of Associate Professor in 2011. She was appointed Head of Department, Political Science and Public Administration, 2016-2017. She was the first female Head of Department, Political Science and Public Administration and first female professor in the same Department. She was promoted from the rank of Associate professor to the rank of Professor effective January 01, 2021.

#### **CHRISTIAN LIFE**

Late Deaconess (Professor) Enobong D. Umoh was born into the Qua Iboe doctrine. She later embraced the doctrine of The Apostolic Church Nigeria, which was the doctrine of her late husband, late Elder (Engr.) David Isaac Umoh. She did this whole heartedly, got baptized and worshiped God on this platform till her death. She was very committed and served God frightfully in His vineyard. Her passion for God's work saw her accept the call as a Deaconess in the body of Christ. Mummy was a devoted Witness member. She was also a very active member in the Women's Movement of the church.

#### MARITALLIFE

"And you, be ye fruitful and multiply; bring forth abundantly in the Earth and multiply therein" (Gen. 17:20). With respect to the above scripture, our dear mother got married to Late Elder (Engr.) David I. Umoh of Afaha Akpan Ekpo Village in Etinan Local Government of Akwa Ibom State. The Union was blessed with four (4) children.

Late Deaconess (Professor) Enobong D. Umoh was a very sociable person, caring, accommodating, cheerful and intelligent. She was a mother to so many. 


